#### **Psalm 119:137-144      New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)**

<sup>137</sup> You are righteous, O Lord, and your judgments are right. <sup>138</sup> You have appointed your decrees in righteousness and in all faithfulness. <sup>139</sup> My zeal consumes me because my foes forget your words. <sup>140</sup> Your promise is well tried, and your servant loves it. <sup>141</sup> I am small and despised, yet I do not forget your precepts. <sup>142</sup> Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and your law is the truth. <sup>143</sup> Trouble and anguish have come upon me, but your commandments are my delight. <sup>144</sup> Your decrees are righteous forever; give me understanding that I may live.

How can we know the way?” <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. <sup>7</sup> If you know me, you will know my Father also. also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father.
